Heavy rainfall can cause stormwater and sewage system overflows, which is a risk to public health.

Contaminated flood waters damage crops and impact the health of livestock.

Increased temperatures accelerate bacterial growth rates and the transfer of antimicrobial-resistant genes between microorganisms.
